**Undergraduate Research Bursaries in Mathematics**  
**Assessment Guidance for the URB Advisory Board**

Assessors will assign a score of 0 to 5 for each of the three criteria: ***Student Suitability***, ***Project Suitability*** and ***Supervision Quality*** according to the following definitions:

- 5 – outstanding:** The application very strongly meets all the assessment criteria without weaknesses.
- 4 – excellent:** The application strongly meets the assessment criteria with only one or two minor weaknesses.
- 3 – very good:** The application meets the assessment criteria well with some minor weaknesses.
- 2 – good:** The application meets the assessment criteria but with clear weaknesses.
- 1 – adequate:** The application meets the assessment criteria but with significant weaknesses.
- 0 – unsatisfactory:** The application fails to meet one or more of the assessment criteria.
